Payroll Giving - what is it?

It's an easy, tax-free way to help your favourite charity or good cause. A regular amount is taken from your weekly/monthly pay BEFORE income tax is deducted. If you're paid monthly and pledge £5 a month, it will cost you just £4 if you pay tax at the basic rate.

Your monthly pledge	Actual cost to you (20% tax payer)	Actual cost to you (40% tax payer)
£5 (Approx 17p per day)	£4.00	£3.00
£10 (Approx 34p per day)	£8.00	£6.00
£15 (Approx 50p per day)	£12.00	£9.00

Our charitable agency, Charities Trust, deducts a fee of 25p per monthly deduction to cover costs.

How do I join the scheme?

Just complete the attached Pledge Form with details of the charity/charities you would like to donate to and how much you wish to give each pay day. Then send the form to the PGA freepost address. PGA will then arrange for your donation to be deducted from your next available salary.
